

395 Lane Closure Content – Week of July 1

The express version

- **Weather permitting, there are upcoming closures on the I-395 HOV and regular lanes this week**
- **Look out for detours and drive safely**

Be prepared for overnight and daytime HOV lane closures

Roadwork for the I-395 HOV lanes requires an overnight closure of the HOV lanes from near Edsall Rd. to the 14th St. Bridge. Weather permitting, the closure will take place during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 8 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 8 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.

Roadwork along the I-395 HOV lanes may require daytime closures to accommodate project activities. Weather permitting, closures would potentially take place during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- Wednesday, July 3: 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Due to the 4th of July holiday travel, there will be no HOV closures on the weekend.

Also be on the lookout for overnight and daytime closures on the regular lanes

Daytime closures in the I-395 south left regular lanes will occur during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Wednesday, July 3: 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Daytime closures in the I-395 north left regular lanes will occur during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Wednesday, July 3: 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Roadwork along King Street to I-395 South requires overnight closure of the King Street eastbound to I-395 south ramp. Detour info is below. Weather permitting, the closure will take place during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.

Roadwork along I-395 South will require overnight total closures of the Shirlington Circle to I-395 South ramp. A detour will be in place. Weather permitting the closure will take place during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.

Roadwork along I-395 South will require overnight total closures of the I-395 SB exit ramp on to Duke Street (Exit 3A). A detour will be in place. Weather permitting the closure will take place during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.

Roadwork along I-395 South will require overnight total closures of the I-395 SB exit ramp on to westbound Edsall Road (Exit 2B). A detour will be in place. Weather permitting the closure will take place during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.

Roadwork along I-395 south will require an overnight, single-lane closure on the right regular lane. This may expand to a double-lane closure, if necessary. Weather permitting, closures may take place on the following nights:

- Monday, July 1: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.

Roadwork along I-395 south will require an overnight, two-lane closure on the left regular lanes. This may expand to a double-lane closure, if necessary. Weather permitting, closures may take place on the following nights:

- Monday, July 1: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.
- Tuesday, July 2: 12 a.m. to 4:30 a.m.

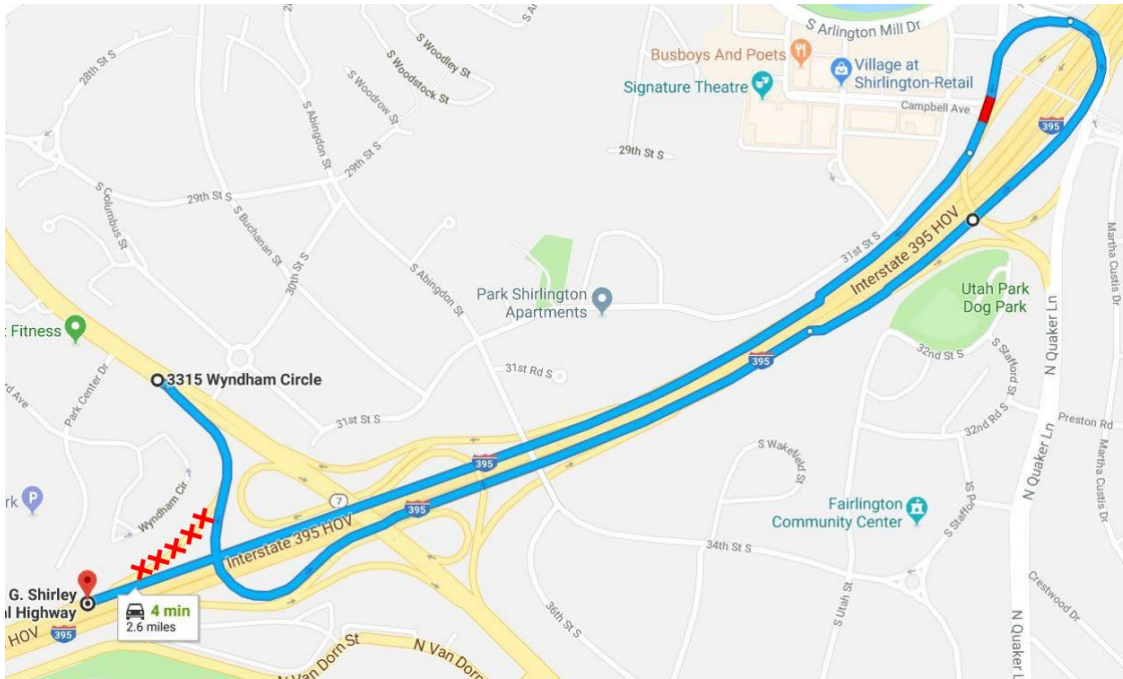
Due to scheduled work for the I-395 Express Lanes project, ramps will be narrowed at Duke Street and Seminary Road during the following times:

- Monday, July 1: 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. if northbound; 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. if southbound
- Tuesday, July 2: 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. if northbound; 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. if southbound

Due to scheduled work for the I-395 Express Lanes project, the I-395 North on-ramp at Shirlington Circle has been narrowed to one lane until otherwise indicated.

Detour

To access I-395 South, drivers traveling east on King Street will need to take the I-395 exit ramp and turn left onto I-395 North, turn right onto Exit 6 Shirlington, follow the signs to Shirlington and then get back onto I-395 South.
